PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

University Safety Office: Policies and Compliance

- **Regulatory Compliance** Adhere to **DOLE OSH Standards** and university safety policies.
- **Risk Management** Conduct regular hazard identification, safety inspections, and preventive measures.
- **Incident Reporting** Ensure that all accidents, hazards, and near-misses are reported and documented immediately.
- **Emergency Preparedness** Maintain evacuation plans, first aid stations, and emergency response protocols.
- Safety Training & Awareness—Implement mandatory training, drills, toolbox meetings, Job Safety Analyses, and workshops for staff.
- **Proper Use of Equipment & PPE**—Ensure the proper use, maintenance, and availability of safety equipment and PPE.
- Laboratory and Clinical Safety Require strict compliance with DOH and DOLE regulations, proper handling and disposal of hazardous chemicals and biological waste, mandatory use of PPE (gloves, lab coats, safety goggles), and adherence to infection control protocols to ensure a safe working environment.
- Construction and Facility Safety Contractors must comply with the DOLE OSH compliance, proper PPE for workers (helmets, harnesses, gloves), daily site inspections by safety officers, and clear warning signs and barriers in a construction zone.
- **Monitoring & Continuous Improvement** Regularly update policies through audits, feedback, and safety assessments.

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES of the University Safety Office:

1. Emergency Preparedness & Response

- Emergency Plans: Help develop response protocols for fires, earthquakes, medical emergencies, and security threats.
- Safety Drills: Assist in conducting regular drills for fire, earthquakes, and lockdowns that engage all stakeholders.

2. Occupational Health & Safety Compliance

- Regular workplace safety inspections and risk assessments.
- Enforcing PPE use and hazard control in high-risk areas.

Compliance with **DOLE OSH Standards** and environmental safety regulations

3. Safety Awareness & Training

- Mandatory safety orientations for employees and contractors.
- Assist in disaster preparedness.
- Awareness campaigns through posters and safety digital bulletins.

4. Incident Reporting & Investigation

- Efficient accident and injury reporting system.
- Root cause analysis and preventive action implementation.
- Coordinate with the university clinic for medical assistance.

5. Campus Security & Risk Management

- Collaborated with USO security personnel for campus safety.
- Assist with traffic control and pedestrian safety.

6. Continuous Safety Improvement

- Conduct regular safety audits and policy updates.
- Compliance with regulatory agencies (**DOLE, BFP, DOH**).
- Stakeholder feedback for program enhancement.
