

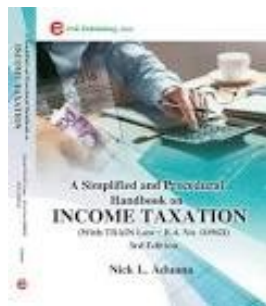

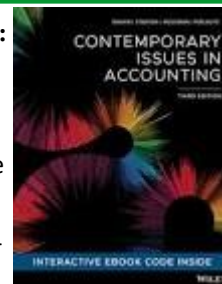

It is expected that this significant breakthrough in taxation law will hasten economic growth and promote investments.

In this edition, the latest revenue regulation and related issuances issued by tax government authorities have been incorporated. The book still maintains the procedural approach and step-by-step process to facilitate the learning process of the students. It also provides illustrative examples to properly guide the students.

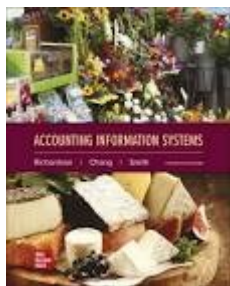
