TO : All Personnel, Students, and Parents/Guardians – Salvador Campus
SUBJECT : **Trial traffic scheme for Salvador Campus – starts Monday, September 22, 2025**

For the safety of our community and in support of the City Government's efforts to improve traffic along La Purisima Street, Ateneo de Zamboanga University will implement the following **trial traffic scheme** at the **Salvador Campus** beginning **Monday, September 22, 2025**, until further notice. These adjustments ask a bit more from each of us so that many more—inside and beyond our campus—can move safely and well.

Key Guidelines

1. **Drop-off/Pick-up for private four-wheel vehicles (Nuñez side only)**
 - Gate 6 (Nuñez St.) – Quick drop-off/pick-up.
 - Gate 4 (Nuñez Extension) – Now open for **quick drop-off/pick-up inside the gate driveway**. A temporary waiting area is available inside Gate 4 for brief pick-ups.
 - **15-second rule:** Stops should take about **15 seconds**. Passengers should be ready to alight/board; drivers remain in the vehicle.
2. **La Purisima frontage**
 - **No drop-off/pick-up for private four-wheel vehicles.**
 - **Motorcycles and tricycles may stop briefly (up to 15 seconds) only.**
 - **No waiting** along La Purisima.
3. **No roadside waiting on either street**
 - Do **not** wait or park along **Nuñez or La Purisima**.
 - Students and personnel should **notify drivers only when already ready to board** so vehicles arrive and depart promptly.
4. **Pedestrian entry during peak hours**
 - SHS, College, and other student pedestrians are **advised to enter via Gate 1.5 (nearer Metrobank)** to ease congestion at Gate 2.
5. **Rain safety**
 - Two canopy projects are scheduled: **MPCC 1 → Sauras Hall**, and **inside Gate 4 toward the JMR Building and the walkway beside the Jesuit Residence**. Installation will take time. **Please bring umbrellas/rain gear** in the meantime. **MPCC 1** may be used as a **covered passageway** during rain.

6. **Enforcement and assistance**

- The **City Government** will strictly enforce **no-waiting** rules and deploy additional traffic enforcers in these areas.
- University personnel and campus security will be on site to guide vehicles and pedestrians, especially during peak hours.

A shared effort for the common good

These changes may mean a **longer walk inside campus** and a bit more planning for pick-ups. Thank you for embracing this small inconvenience as a concrete way we can **protect one another** and **support the city's well-being**. Our cooperation helps keep intersections clear, prevents accidents, and serves our neighbors.
