SUBJECT : **Advisory on the Resumption of Classes and Office Operations**

Following the earthquake felt this morning, the University conducted an initial assessment of its campus facilities. Based on initial reports, no structural damage has been reported at this time. Further precautionary checking will continue tomorrow, June 9, 2026.

As a precaution, and considering the possibility of aftershocks, **Senior High School face-to-face activities shall remain suspended tomorrow**. Activities may be conducted online or asynchronous as determined by the Senior High School administration.

For Higher Education and the Professional Schools, **face-to-face classes may resume tomorrow**, subject to the guidance of their respective academic leaders. Teachers may shift classes online or asynchronous when needed.

Office work will also resume tomorrow, subject to the guidance of unit heads and appropriate safety precautions.

All members of the University community are reminded to remain alert and prepared to follow safety protocols should strong aftershocks occur.

The University will continue to monitor the situation and issue further advisories as needed.

Thank you for your cooperation.
