SUBJECT : **Resumption of Face-to-face Classes and Office Operations**

Following the reassessment conducted today by the team from the Physical Plant Office (PPO), together with CSITE engineers Engr. Calisang and Engr. Papa, the findings indicate that the cracks observed following the recent earthquake are non-structural in nature and do not affect the overall structural integrity of the affected facilities. As such, only minor repair works are recommended.

In light of these findings, **face-to-face classes and office operations shall resume tomorrow, June 10, 2026.**

Senior High School students may continue using the FWS Building for their classes, except for Room 504. Repair works in Room 504 will commence tomorrow and are expected to be completed by Friday. Appropriate arrangements for classes assigned to Room 504 shall be coordinated by the Senior High School administration.

The University will continue to monitor campus facilities and undertake the necessary repairs to ensure a safe learning and working environment for all.

We thank the members of the University community for their patience, cooperation, and vigilance during this period.

The safety and well-being of our students, personnel, and the wider AdZU community remain our priority.
